Dear Parents & Guardians,

It's time to register for the **2025-2026 school year**, and we are excited to offer our scholars the opportunity to select their courses beginning the week of May 12 and concluding Friday, May 23!

Please note that course selection **does not guarantee** enrollment in a specific class. Instead, it helps our registration team determine the number of sections needed for each course. In the coming week, we will meet with students to provide guidance on requesting courses through PowerSchool. However, if you want to get a jump start, the directions are below.

Course Selection Instructions:

Step 1: Log into **PowerSchool** and select **Class Registration** from the menu on the left.

Step 2: Review the instructions for your grade level. Every student must request a total of **8 credits**. *(Elective alternatives do not count toward this total—they are only used if your first-choice elective is unavailable.)*

Step 3: Click the small **pencil icon** next to each course category to view available classes.

- A **red exclamation mark (!)** means a required section is missing.
- A **green check (✓)** means all required sections are complete.

Step 4: Continue selecting courses for each required section.

- A **red exclamation mark (!)** means more courses are needed.
- A **green check (✓)** means the requirement is met.

Step 5: Once all courses are selected, scroll to the bottom and click **Submit** on the right.

Step 6: After submission, you will return to the home registration page.

- Ensure that you see the courses you selected.
- Confirm that a **green check** appears and that you have selected **at least 8 credits**.
